DESCRIPTION & PERFORMANCE:

The Runabout is the classic model featuring traditional design elements. Its hull shape is derived from the original runabout plans from the 1920's and 1930's. This model is steeped in a timeless heritage with traditional lines and aesthetic features including traditional hardware, three-part louvered windscreen and a sweeping tumble home aft.

The concave warped bottom provides a gliding and graceful ride, cutting through reasonable chop. Ideal conditions are under 1 meter.
